Important Deadlines:

Grant proposals must be received at the Foundation office no later than noon on the deadline date:

For current year consideration intent must be received by August 1.

Grant proposals due: September 15

Proposal Narrative:

The proposal narrative is the most important part of your grant proposal. In two to five pages, please address the following:

- A brief history of your organization;
- The needs being addressed;
- A description of the proposed program's or project's purpose, including how it will address the needs identified; and the specific population served with specific number of people affected;
- Your organization's qualifications to address the issue:
- Amount of funding requested;
- Total cost of the project;
- Contributions of all parties, if the project is a collaborative one:
- A timetable for the proposed project/program;
- Specific plans for evaluations and how outcomes are determined that are expected;
- Plans for continuation of the project or program including projected funding options.
