Scholarship deadline for submission is Friday, March 5th, 2021, by 5pm.

To apply for a scholarship with the Cherokee Strip Community Foundation:

- Complete the CSCF Scholarship Application Form accompanying each scholarship
- Provide any scholarship-specific addendums to the application form
- Include a copy of your submitted FAFSA application
- Submit current transcript with ACT scores

Other notes:

- Please submit individual applications and scholarship-specific addendums separately
 - For example, if applying to multiple scholarships, put each scholarship application and specific addendums in the same envelope/folder and the second in another envelope/folder.
- Do not provide attachments that are not requested by the scholarship.

Bernard D. Mayer, Jr. Memorial Scholarship

About:

Bernard Dreyfus Mayer, Jr. was born October 6, 1939 in Enid, Oklahoma. After graduating from Enid High School, Bernie graduated from the University of Houston with a BS in Chemistry. He attended MIT pursuing graduate work, obtained his MS in Mathematics from Mellon College of Science at the Carnegie Institute of Technology in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

It was with Mobil Oil that Bernie met Judy Turner and they were together 27 years, traveling and enjoying life together. Bernie really enjoyed returning to Oklahoma to visit many friends in the Enid and OKC area and he especially enjoyed returning to attend his high school reunions in Enid.

Bernard Mayer believed that students “who are deserving and show a willingness to work hard” would be prime candidates for this scholarship. For these reasons, the selection committee tries to be flexible in its review of scholarship candidates. They not only consider need and scholastic performance, but also look for traits which Bernie held in such high regard.

Award:

The \$1,000.00 scholarship is granted directly to the Bursar’s office at the institution the recipient chooses, upon evidence of enrollment in an eligible institution. The scholarship is to be awarded one time, not on a recurring basis.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Student demonstrates financial need
- Student is a good citizen with high moral and social standards
- Maintains a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, confirmed on official transcript
- The student plans to attend a college, university or technical school supported by the state of Oklahoma.
- The student has graduated from an accredited high school or equivalent institution, preference given to Enid High School students.
- The student is not related to any member of the selection committee.

Required Addendums:

- One letter of recommendation from a teacher.
- A one-page essay which expresses the goals the applicant is working toward or what the applicant expects from their education, and explanation of financial need.
- A copy of the applicant’s most recent transcript.
